1 John chapter 2

What is John's purpose in writing this? [1] Why would he care?

How can you know whether a person truly knows God? [3-6] What is the old and new command? [7-11]

John had more reasons for writing in 12-14; does he intend these groups to be exclusive (marking out what separates them) or, rather, inclusive (highlighting how they are similar)? What is common to all of them? (See also 20-21)

In 18-27 John warns against false teachings and false teachers; what key test does he give us to distinguish the liars from those who know the truth? [22-23]

1 John chapter 3

Lavish love! Children of God! (*Who's your daddy?*) How do the children of God live? [1-8] How can you tell who is (or *is not*) a child of God? [9-10, 14] Compare also 2:1.

What is love? [16-18] How do we know whether we're doing it right? [19-21, 24].

Can we really "receive from him anything we ask"? [22-23; see also 5:14-15 and John 14:13-14]

1 John chapter 4

"Do not believe every spirit". How can you recognize the Spirit of God? [1-3; *also* 2:22-23] How should we respond to the spirit of antichrist? [4-6]

According to verses 7-8, who is a child of God? How do we in the world, who have never seen God, come to know Him? [12] How do we know He lives in us and we in Him? [13-16] How can we have confidence on the day of judgment? [17-21] https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6_dWPu8RI5U>
