2 Chronicles Chapter 1

At the very beginning of Solomon's reign he went to the tabernacle to worship God. Who was with him? What was the key feature of his worship there?

Where was the tabernacle located, and where was the ark of God?

It might be said that Solomon exhibited wisdom in his prayer. What was it he prayed for? Did Solomon's request(s) match God's priorities? What was God's priority?

What was life like in Jerusalem at the beginning of Solomon's reign?

2 Chronicles Chapter 7

What event confirmed God's acceptance of the temple in Jerusalem as the place where He dwelt among His people? Who worshiped the Lord there, and what form(s) did their worship take? Why couldn't the priests enter the temple?

This chapter appears to be the pinnacle of Israel's success: everything before led up to this and everything after is a long heart-breaking decline.

When God appeared to Solomon what warning(s) and promise(s) did He give to the king? Are god's promises absolutely and unconditionally reliable, or are there strings attached and escape clauses in the fine print?

2 Chronicles Chapter 36

Who appointed Jehoahaz as king over Judah? Who removed him and appointed a new king? How is this different from the nation's first kings?

In what manner was God involved in the relationship between between the king of Judah and the king of Babylon? [13]

"Who killed their young men with the sword in the sanctuary, and spared neither young man nor young woman, old man or aged"? [17] (There are at least 3 answers.)
