Who fights against Jerusalem, and why? Who defends Jerusalem? What happens to the attackers? [3-14]

What happens after the great battle? [16-21] (*Compare Deuteronomy 16:13-16*)

This chapter describes the (still to come) Day of the Lord. What are the primary features of that day? There will be much excitement, do you want to be part of it?
